

### After the interview

Directly after your interview, you will be handed a card which makes one of the following offers:

- **Unconditional**  
(you already hold the entry qualifications for your chosen course) and there are places available;
- **Conditional**  
(you have been offered a place providing you achieve the required entry qualifications for your course);
- **Deferred**  
(we need to get further information before we make an offer).

### Keeping in contact

Your or your parents are welcome to call or visit the college at any time if you have any concerns about your course. If you change your mind, just phone Admissions, you don't need to fill in another application form.

### Freshers' day

Freshers' day is an important part of your preparation for attending college. It will take place on Thursday 28 June 2012. You should try to attend so that you can meet your teachers and fellow students, re-visit the campus and see what Street has to offer you.

If you cannot attend pre-induction day you should let the Teaching Team know so that materials can be sent to you separately.

### Holidays

You are strongly urged NOT to take holidays over the enrolment period which is from 23 August until 31 August.

### Enrolment procedures

All applicants holding an offer will be sent enrolment arrangement letters in mid-July. These letters should be kept safely and brought to college for your designated appointment on the appropriate day and time.

### Results and offers

Those holding conditional offers who have not achieved the entry requirements should still attend enrolment at the specified time. Alternative courses will be discussed at this time.

### Late enrolments

If, having received your enrolment appointment, you cannot make that date and or time; you should contact the Admissions Office, to make another arrangement.

If you are unable to attend the main enrolment event, there is no guarantee that the subject(s) or course you have chosen will still have places available.
